The seniors are selling holiday greenery. Contact Paul Wood, senior class sponsor, or any senior. Do it quickly as the sale ends soon!

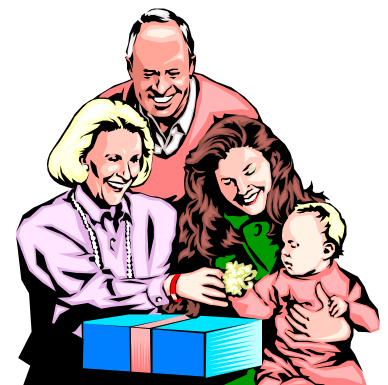

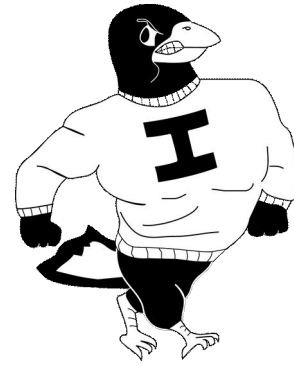
