Clothing Checklist

Preschool/Elementary Students

Clothing:

- 5 school outfits
- play clothes (if desired)
- 5 or more pairs of underwear
- 5 or more pairs of socks
- 2 pairs of pajamas
(more if your child is a bed wetter)
- robe/slippers
- swim suit
- 1 pair of school shoes
- 2 pairs of athletic shoes
(one for school, one for dorm)

- jacket or sweater
- raincoat
- heavy coat/hat/mittens/boots
(for cold weather)

Personal Items:

- shampoo
- conditioner
- face/body soap
- bathing/shower cap (if desired)
- toothbrush
- toothpaste
- deodorant
- box of tissues
- hairbrush/comb
- hair accessories (for girls)
- feminine hygiene products
(for girls, if needed)

- sheets
- pillow
- bedspread/blanket
- laundry bag for dirty clothes

- family pictures for locker
- doll or favorite stuffed animal

Important Information:

- Please mark your child's name on all clothing and personal items.
- It is not recommended that your child to bring expensive toys to the residential halls.
- Laundry rooms are available to launder your child's clothing. Parents are responsible to provide money for the machines and soap.
- Movies G or PG are permitted.

Clothing Checklist

Middle/High School Students

Clothing:

- clothing for 5-7 days
(including school and play)
- 2-3 sets of pajamas/sleepwear
- bathrobe/slippers
- 7-10 pairs of underwear
- 7-10 pairs of socks
- 4-5 brassieres (for girls)
- swim suit
- 1-2 pairs of shoes
(including athletic shoes)

- jacket or sweater
- coat/hat/gloves/boots
(for cold weather)
- raincoat/umbrella

Students may also bring the following

OPTIONAL items:

- small television
- room decorations
- lamps
- alarm clock with vibrator or flashing light
(recommended for High School students)

Personal Items:

- face/body soap
- shampoo
- conditioner
- bathing cap (if desired)
- hairbrush/comb
- hair accessories (for girls)
- toothbrush
- toothpaste
- mouthwash
- deodorant
- box of tissues
- hand lotion
- feminine hygiene products (for girls)

- sheets (extra long twin sheets)
- blanket/bedspread
- pillow
- laundry basket/bag/hamper
- laundry detergent/stain
remover/dryer sheets/etc.
- towels/wash cloths

Important Information:

- Laundry machines for student use cost \$.75 per washer or dryer.
- Snack bar and off-campus activities are available, so students may need spending money for the week.
- Students are responsible for handling their own funds. It is recommended that large amounts of money be given to the Assistant Dean to lock up. ISD is not responsible for money not locked in the office.
